- Prepare risk/control analysis, analyze business processes/flows, and perform tests of the effectiveness of controls
- Provide recommendations to improve operations and internal controls
- In collaboration with management, coordinate and facilitate MGIC's annual assessment of internal control over financial reporting in accordance with legal/regulatory requirements
- Participate on special project teams and perform special projects, as needed
- Coordinate and manage assistance provided to the external auditors, the GSEs and other regulators during their examinations
